   Most applicants will be able to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool
  to populate income questions, but bring IRS 1040 forms and W2s in case.
   Information about all assets (savings, stocks, investments), if applicable.
- Driver's license number(s)
- Dates of birth (month, date year)
- Month and year of marriage, separation, divorce or other change in marital status
- Non-citizen students and parents should bring alien registration number, if available
- List of colleges you are interested in attending after high school
- A cell phone that can receive text messages and access to an email account
